PURPOSE

Copley-Fairlawn Athletic Association (CAA) and Indians Fastpitch are committed to providing a safe, positive, and development-focused environment for all players. Youth softball exists to promote:

- Player development, Confidence and character, Sportsmanship, Respect for the game

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

CAA enforces a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for the mistreatment of:

- Umpires, Coaches, Players, Opposing spectators

This policy applies to all games, practices, tournaments, and team events.

SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

As a parent/guardian — and for any guest I bring — I agree to:

- Cheer positively for all players, allow coaches to communicate with umpires, Respect umpire decisions
- Address concerns through league leadership — not during games

Spectators **MAY NOT:**

- Argue or dispute umpire calls, use profanity or demeaning language, Yell at or confront players, coaches, or opposing fans, Approach umpires before, during, or after a game, engage in threatening or aggressive behavior

ONLY THE HEAD COACH MAY ADDRESS AN UMPIRE

ENFORCEMENT

I understand violations of this policy may result in:

- Immediate warning, Immediate removal from the facility, Suspension from future games, Season ban, Possible team discipline, including forfeiture. Egregious situations may result from banning other CAA sports/activities.
